Bread was present on the table <i>tamid</i>	Ex 25:30 (76)
Incense ascended from the golden altar <i>tamid</i>	Ex 30:1, 8 (81)
The High Priest wore on his heart the names of Israel <i>tamid</i>	Ex 28:29 (79)
