

## 5. Revelation's Final Millennium

At the beginning of, during, and after, the 1000 years, we see what Jesus does with the righteous and all the wicked, including Satan. At the end of this period all are gathered around the great white throne. Then it is that all of the wicked will receive the wages of sin which is death. Then Jesus will recreate this world as the final dwelling place for God and the all the redeemed.

1. When Jesus comes at the beginning of the 1000 years, "out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it he should \_\_\_\_\_ the nations."

2. What does Jesus do at this time to the righteous that have remained loyal, even in the face of death? "And they \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ with Christ for a thousand years...This is the \_\_\_\_\_."

5. Will the wicked survive this event? "And the rest were \_\_\_\_\_ with the sword which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse." Rev 19:21

6. Because the wicked are now all dead and the righteous have been "caught up" to be with the Lord where does that leave Satan at this time? "He laid hold of the dragon, that serpent of old, who is the Devil and Satan, and \_\_\_\_\_

## 5. Revelation's Final Millennium – page two

7. What is the condition of this world during the 1000 years? Rev 20:1 calls it “the \_\_\_\_\_ pit” Gk. *abussos* or “deep” an expression also used in Genesis in the Greek OT (Septuagint or LXX) to describe the earth at the beginning of creation (Gen 1:2).
8. Where are the righteous during the 1000 years? The righteous “reign \_\_\_\_\_ for a thousand years.” Rev 20:4 (1188) Jesus told His disciples where I am going you cannot follow Me \_\_\_\_\_ but you shall follow Me \_\_\_\_\_...” Jn 13:36 (1042); see also 14:1-3
9. What do the righteous do during the 1000 years? “And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and \_\_\_\_\_ was \_\_\_\_\_ to them.” Rev 20:4 (1188)
10. What is the final destination for the New Jerusalem? “I John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem coming down \_\_\_\_\_ from God.” Rev 21:2 (1189)
11. What will happen next? “The rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years \_\_\_\_\_.” Rev 20:5 (1188)
12. At this time what happens to Satan? “Now when the thousand years have expired, Satan will be \_\_\_\_\_ from his prison.” Rev 20:7 (1188)
13. After a “little while” Satan and all the wicked come before the great white throne and are “judged according to their WORKS”. It is at this time that all the wicked are destroyed in the lake of fire; “This is the second \_\_\_\_\_.” Rev 20:9-15 (1188)
14. At the last John “saw a \_\_\_\_\_ and a \_\_\_\_\_ for the first heaven and the first earth had \_\_\_\_\_ away.” Rev 21:1 (1189)
