like sheep without a Shepherd. Jesus had the ability to see below the surface, beyond the obvious, and view others with insight and understanding. He saw people like me, a little confused and without clear direction, going through the motions as best that they can.

As I drove up to the baggage claim curb, I spotted the now empty bench where I'd placed the backpack. Discouraged, I then spotted a group of airport police talking with each other nearby. Nothing to lose, I interrupted them, asking if anyone had turned in a backpack an hour or so earlier. One officer stepped out. "Was it a black backpack? Did it have a computer in it?" Relief flooded my entire being as I described the bag and its contents. Yes, he had found my backpack, turning it into Lost & Found. He told me the number to call, and since it contained important documents, informed me that I might be able to get it even though the offices were closed.

Feeling God's presence is overwhelming and can be hard to put into words. The reminder of His love and care in that moment was palpable. I thanked the supervisor profusely, briefly sharing the experience and about how much I appreciated the kindness shown by his officers. Upon hearing this, the supervisor called the officer on the radio, so I could thank him again in person. You see, the gratitude I showed that evening was out of the norm. The supervisor shared with me how his officers are often treated daily, examples like being called Nazis for not letting people park their cars at baggage claim. That this officer, despite that regular level of abuse, was still able to be so kind and professional to me, gave me another glimpse of how Jesus can work through each of us, no matter our circumstances.
